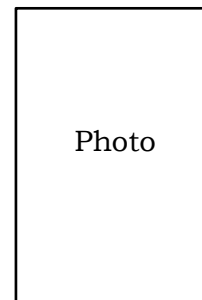


General information about the “Introduction to Translation” Program
